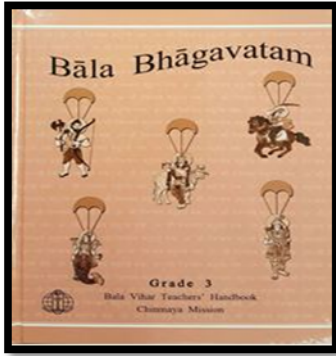
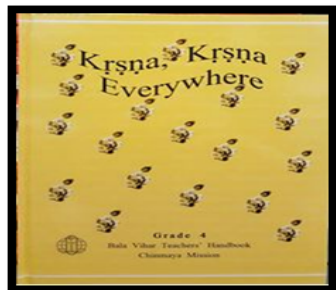

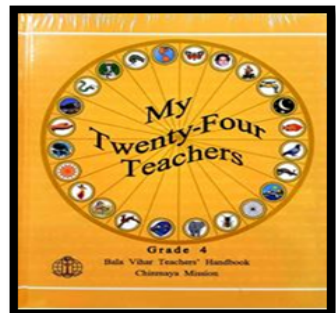
### Grade 3

Through the stories of different avatars of Lord Vishnu, children learn to own up to their actions. They learn to ask for only what they need, and not necessarily what they desire.

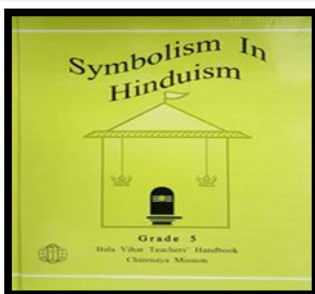


### Grade 4

(1) Encourage children to learn about sharing and self-discipline through the stories of Lord Krishna. They learn to introspect and record their observations regularly.

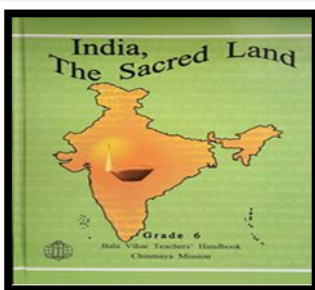

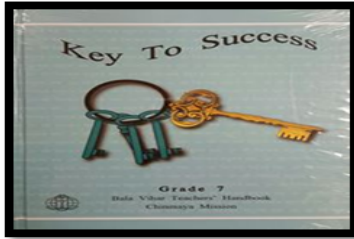


### Grade 5 (Not Applicable)

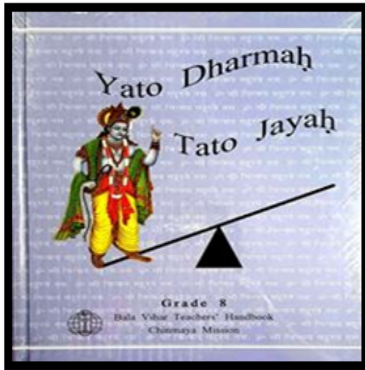

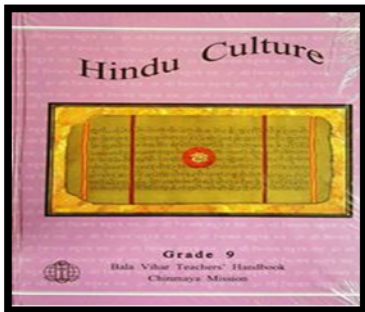
Grade 6+7

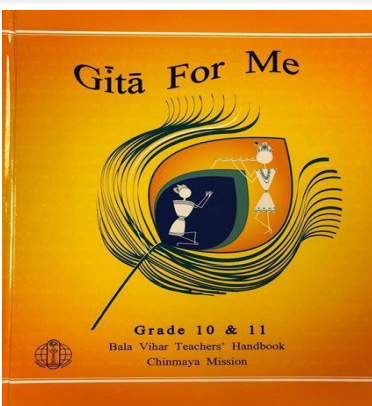
Grade 8

Accomplish the goal of life by following the Hindu Sanskriti. Learn to live a stress free life by applying the message of Upanishads.



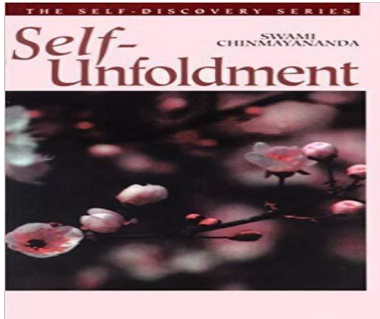
Grade 10, 11, 12
